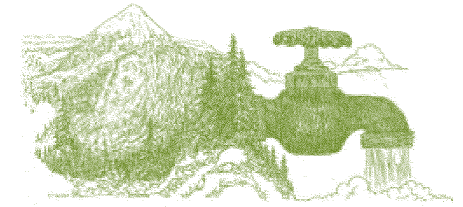


VOTE FOR *Water & Old Growth Forest*

- That ALL drinking watersheds have to be protected. No mining or forestry licenses, including that of the Community Forest, can be located in these watersheds.
- That there should be no logging of any old growth forest, in or out of the watersheds. Old growth forests are a key part of a healthy ecosystem and are irreplaceable.
- That open and transparent governance of the Community Forest, owned by the District of Sechelt and operating on public land, is a must, including public participation in the selection of directors.
